

Understanding NGPC Area Development & Notification Processes – A Collaborative Approach

In the interest of encouraging Community collaboration for North Glenmore Park Planning & Area Redevelopment issues, the NGPCA has defined the communication process for Development Circulations in the following chart below:

City of Calgary receives an application/circulation.
Simultaneously, the circulation is added to the following areas:

- 1) posted to City of Calgary **interactive development map site**: <https://developmentmap.calgary.ca/#map>
- 2) physical **notification board placed on subject lot** (Urban Planner contact details found on this sign)
- 3) **Community Association emailed or mailed** copy of circulation
